The 4th chip in this popular but controversial series was issued on Monday, December 9^{th} at the Plaza.

Once again, severe limits were placed on this already restricted number of 300 chips that were manufactured ... and set-asides, or holdbacks of chips, were in place again for the "restaurant owners". With over 25 chippers standing in line for the preannounced 11 a.m. release, chip purchases were limited to four chips per person and those who needed or wanted more were allowed to return to the back of the line until the supply was quickly exhausted in less than fifteen minutes. Luckily, I had a few friends in line who purchased chips for me ... but still not enough for all of my subscribers.

Originally scheduled for release at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, December 28th, the actual release was rescheduled for 1:00 p.m. 1,000 chips were issued and 800 were put on the table with a \$100 limit per person (20chips). Another 100 chips were held back for release on Sunday, and the final 100 were to be put on the table for New Years Eve. At 7 p.m. on Saturday evening, Brenda and I counted 12+ stacks still on the table.

Manv of those subscribers on the list below have pre-paid for their chips in

advance. Some have paid partial payments. Some have paid for the chips, but have not included the postage. I need to know NOW, how many chips to order. If you have not already made your intentions known, now is the time to do so.
