In my February Atlantic City Newsletter, I made an announcement regarding two Resorts International \$100 chips that were reportedly transposed in my 2001 and earlier catalogs. (RES-100c & RES-100d)

BE ADVISED THAT THE CATALOG IS CORRECT AS ORIGINALLY ISSUED!

Separate sources had advised me that the catalog listings regarding these two \$100 chips were transposed. A brief look at the \$100 chips currently on the tables at Resorts, shortly after this matter had been referred to me, initially appeared that the sources were correct.

HOWEVER

... while examining the specimens in question which are housed in my personal reference collection in the vault over this past weekend ... I've determined <u>without question</u> that the sources were incorrect and that my original attributions are accurate and need not be modified.

chip was put on the tables for a few days until an investigation took place....



Well, sometime during the last week of January, 2002 the former back-up chips re-appeared on the tables at Claridge ... and promptly caused quite a stir on the electronic message boards... It was pulled from the casino floor on Tuesday, February 5th., and all were returned to the vault. E-bay auctions that closed on February 9th and 10th saw these chips sell for \$180 and \$160 respectively. I'm told that (79) \$100's are still outstanding and now that all the excitement has died down, perhaps some of those folks who have substantial numbers of these chips tied up in inventory on speculation, may want to cash them in to the cage and will offer them to me first. (Hah! Fat chance)

At any rate, I did pick up four of the yellow inserts back-up version for my current \$100 subscribers at \$110 each ... and I purchased another one at face from a fellow collector, but alas that was not enough chips for everyone who wanted one. I had intended to pick up additional chips but by the time I got back to A.C. on Wednesday for the Boardwalk Bullies hockey game, they had all been returned to the cage. Sorry, I have none left for sale. I have attempted to make other provisions for someone else who may have extras to mail out these chips to my subscribers who wanted one.
