They were sold for \$10 each at the Save The Music Auction held at "The Wave" at Trump Marina on October 11th. Highest bid received for a single item was \$3.400 for a glass etching signed by Alice Cooper. A guitar used by Heart fetched \$1,900. Signed posters and other memorabilia auctioned off realized \$10,000 raised in the charitable auction of Rock & Roll memorabilia.


"CHIPWORTHY" BORGATA NON-REDEEMABLE CHIP


