

This chip was originally distributed exclusively only to those rated players who received an invitation in the mail to come pick up their free chip on February 2nd at the Trump Marina Wild Card Center. A week later, these NCV chips were placed on sale in the Marina gift shop.



HAVE SLOT TOKENS BECOME A HISTORIC RELIC OF THE PAST?

Unfortunately, with the introduction of TITO (Ticket In, Ticket Out) at virtually every property in Atlantic City as well as gaming jurisdictions around the entire country are no longer using slot tokens. I don't see any new tokens being ordered for the new TITO machines. With this issue of my

newsletter, I will be dropping tokens from my new issues service. If you are signed up with me for tokens only, this will be your last free copy of my complimentary e-newsletter.

TRUMP PLAZA CHIP PROBLEMS

Joe G. reports that the order for the announced Valentines Day chip has been cancelled due to the delivery backlog. Also, the planned Chinese New Year chip did not pass the camera coverage test and had to be sent back for redesign of edge markings.

I've been told that the release date for this \$10 Hooters chip won't be until May ... I'm sure that Todd Moyer will let us know when it's ready to go.



NEW CHIP VARIATIONS IN TOWN (RE-ORDERS?)

New \$1 & \$5 chip variations at Trump Marina have made their appearance recently. If you are familiar with the mini-"i" variation of the \$1 gray-ring chip; well the same mini-"i" variation now exists on the \$1 black-ring and the regular \$5 nickel chip. These chips are easily distinguished from their earlier counterparts by looking at the letter "i" in the words "Marina" and "Casino" on the outer white and red rims. The letters i are much smaller than on the original chips.

Above is a scan of the inside core of a \$5 Harrah's metal insert chip with the outer shell peeled away that should help to illustrate how these chips are constructed and why the "mini-i" variation is indeed a legitimate chip variation from a different mold.



What you are looking at above is the chip's inside core, prior to the outer colored plastic being injected into the mold. The high points in high relief on the center core will show through the finished plastic product ... in this case the blue letters and \$5 denomination on the red surface. This core example shown is of the regular "i" vs. the new variation "mini-i". In addition, the new "mini-i" variations have squared sharp edges vs. the rounded edges on the earlier version, and is a much brighter shade of red.

NEW APPRENTICE 2 CHIPS AT TAJ MAHAL ... AUCTION TIME AGAIN!

While Trump Marina's NCV Groundhog Day chip may have been the actual first chip issued during the new year ... on Friday, February 25th, Trump Taj Mahal became the first casino to issue value LE chips in the year 2005 when they released \$5, \$25, \$100 denominations of the successful hit reality TV show, "The Apprentice".

While I was able to pick up enough of the \$5 and \$100 chips for everyone ... the tough chip (again at Taj Mahal) was the quarter! Only 100 \$25 chips were made ... and the two-chip-per-person limits placed on them made it impossible for anyone to get in any sizeable quantities. Brenda and I were fortunate to be able to pick up eight \$25 chips with the help of a couple of friends. Two of the quarter chips are earmarked for my personal collection and the remaining six pieces will be auctioned to the six highest bidders exclusively among my subscribers.

I'm told that all future \$25 LE's issued at Taj Mahal will be intentionally limited to 100 chips. The head suits at Taj wants the \$25 chips from that property to be valuable to collectors and by making such a small number ... draws players to his property ..., as the long line of chippers in attendance at this snowy early Friday afternoon release will testify.

I'm told that all future issues coming out of Taj will only produce 100 quarter chips.
