I am very pleased to announce the introduction of the CCGTCC club mail program. Every active member in good standing of the CCGTCC can receive a FREE email account.

Some of the features of this service are:

It's FREE

Have your ccgtcc.org email forwarded automatically to your primary email address.

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All email is scanned for viruses.

Set up a mail list.

The way it will work is your CCGTCC email address will be your initials and your club membership

number. For example my email address would be

Kg4626@ccgtcc.org

What you will need to do if you want a club email address, is to send me the following:

Name

Membership Number

The password you would like-you can change this once you get into your club mail

Your primary email address

{Optional}. The email address you would like to have your CCGTCC email forwarded to. You can

also set this up once you log into your account.

I will send you the information and the link to get to your email account.

For you dealers or someone who wants something a little different you can have a vanity email

address for a small fee. Vanity accounts will be available very soon. You will be able to pay the fee

on-line just like you pay for your club membership dues. You will need to supply 3 vanity name

choices.

Example-
Chipmaster@ccgtcc.org

The vanity names are just \$5 per month, and must be paid annually by either credit card or check.

Vanity names will be first come first serve and you must pay the fee first. I will post on the CCGTCC

message board when this is available.

A couple final notes. At this time you will not be able to send attachments. From the CCGTCC mail

account. You can receive attachments and forward attachments. There will be a ClubMail

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application on-line
and in the next club
magazine.

design. The new tokens have the
following New Orleans Mardi Gras
themes;

\$5; Mardi Gras mask on obverse, Bass
player on reverse

\$10; Mask on obverse, Juggler on
reverse

\$25; Mask on obverse, Accordion
player on reverse.

\$100; Mask on obverse, Trumpet
player on reverse.

One of my subscribers is offering his 1st Issue Resorts \$25 H&C chip for sale (RES-25) and is now taking offers.

Serious interested buyers are invited to contact me and I'll have the seller contact you directly. Asking price is in the neighborhood of \$2500 -- which is a very reasonable price for a chip of this stature. The edges are not rounded and there are no nicks or dings, according to the seller. This chip is a truly rare specimen as they do not come on the market all that often... and when they do appear..., competition is usually pretty stiff to obtain it.

NOTICE TO ALL SUBSCRIBERS

If you have been receiving these monthly e-newsletters, but not the chips a few days later..., chances are it might be because you are behind in payment for one or more previous shipments. I have no way of knowing if you have received a prior mailing or not, especially those mailings that are uninsured. I try to save my subscribers excessive postal insurance costs on packages valued under \$20 or so by not insuring them. So far, my losses have been negligible. I will continue to mail uninsured packages of lower values, but I have no way of knowing

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that a package has been received at your end until I receive payment for it... and I no longer mail out the following month's package anymore until the previous month is paid for.

99% of you are great by paying promptly each month, but there are a few who do require some occasional prodding once in awhile.

There will NOT be a limit on the amount of chips which you may order.

An order form will be included in the next issue of the National Club Magazine for placing orders. You may order the chips from Archie Black if you are on his subscription service at the same prices.

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Archie has agreed to provide his services on these chips without any profit for himself. Thanks to Archie for his efforts on this program. These chips should become available in either December or early January, 2003. We will NOT take any orders until the order form is in the next issue of the CC>CC National Magazine.
