### RESORTS 25<sup>th</sup> Anniversary NCV SET

#### PLEASE CHECK YOUR MAILING ADDRESS LABELS

The last mailing, in case you had not noticed, was hand addressed due to a printer failure. Got a new printer installed and now would be a good time for everyone to check my codes for your chip wants.

Below your name on the mailing label, you will find following your club membership number, a series of letters, symbols and numbers. This is a simplified code in my database that tells me what chips and tokens to send out to you each mailing.

C=Chip; T=Token; C^5 would mean all chips up to \$5 denomination. T^25= Tokens up to \$25; 2@C^100 means two of each chip up to the \$100 denomination. C1 means \$1 chips only. T1 is \$1 tokens only. LE=Limited Edition chips only.

If you would like to change your new issues requests, please let me know and I'll make the change in my computer.
