The second chip in this popular but controversial series was issued on Monday, November 4th at the Plaza.

Once again, limits were placed on this already restricted number of 300 chips that were manufactured ... and set-asides, or hold-backs of chips, that were in place again for the “restaurant owners”.

Brenda and I got there at 9:30 and already there were four people ahead of us. By 11:00 a.m. there were 26 chip purchasers in line and only 160 chips were brought out to the roulette table for sale to the public. Sales of only five chips per person were rationed and only those first six people in line were able to go through a second time before all 160 chips were consumed. Once again I had some thoughtful help

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from several people in line who bought chips for me.... and once again I have to restrict sales basically to those who got the previous issue, as there were not enough chips to go around.

WHITE HOUSE SUBS LATEST IN PLAZA SERIES

White House Subs has been a famous landmark in A.C. for more years than I can remember. Their claim to fame is that they have allegedly sold over 23 million subs to date. Some of this country's leading political figures and entertainers have patronized this unique eatery.... and their framed photos are on the walls to prove it. Only 140 of the 300 total chips manufactured were released at Trump Plaza on November 13th.... and what a scramble it was!

I heard that the first person in line got there at 8 a.m. for the 11 o'clock release. Brenda and I arrived at 9:30 a.m. and there were already six people in line ahead of us. By 11 am. there were over 30 people in line waiting to buy White House Sub chips. As a result, Plaza management restricted sales to just four chips per person. Only the first six people in line were able to go through a second time before all 140 chips were sold. I confess, I did have some help again from a few extra fine people in line who bought chips for me.... but I was

not able to pick up enough chips to provide all of my subscribers with their needs. Once again, I've arbitrarily put a \$35 per chip price on this tough A.C. chip. In fact, I've been buying the Knife & Fork Inn chips on e-bay at a cost in excess of \$35 including P&I costs. Here are a couple of e-bay examples; Item #729553631 & #731233004.

I'm sincerely trying to fill my customer's needs. Sometimes I will receive a chip return from one or two customers who may not like the \$35 price and I'm then able to send it to other customers who have requested one and didn't receive one in the original mailing. Problem is that I may not be able to do that with all five low issues. Some subscribers may get one or two issues but not the 3^d, 4th or 5th one, depending upon how many chips Trump Plaza releases each time and how many people are in line to purchase them. 120, 140, or 160 chips do not last very long before they are all sold out among 30+ purchasers in line, plus the "set-asides".

Editorial comment: The very low number of \$20 & \$25 chips that are now being issued at Trump Plaza have become increasingly difficult for me to obtain sufficient quantities to supply all of my subscribers. I urge some of the newest subscribers with higher membership numbers to seek a back-up contact to supply these future very limited editions to avoid any disappointments as a result of potential non-delivery from me.

TRUMP PLAZA ISSUES \$25 ONLY “YEAR OF THE HORSE” CHIP

Yep, you read it correctly ... the year ain't over yet ... and The Plaza sneaked this one in just under the wire, on the day after the November 24th A.C. Chapter meeting! Actually, it is a very attractive chip, don't you think?

This chip, like the three restaurant chips issued before it, was severely restricted to just 160 chips brought out for more than 30 chip purchasers in line for up to two hours before the 11 a.m. release time. A four chip per person limit was placed on this issue by casino management. Fortunately (for me and my subscribers) several purchasers did not want more than two chips, and offered to buy extra chips for me. In addition, the first dozen or so in line were allowed to go through a second

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time to purchase four more chips each. To make a long story short; I was able to purchase enough of these chips with a lot of help from some friends so that I can make them available to all my \$25 chip subscribers at my regular new issue price of \$30 each.



Like a boyfriend promising to come back after he plays the field, MGM Mirage said it might still build a casino hotel in Atlantic City after testing the gaming waters elsewhere.

“We'll see how the elections go, see how Borgata opens up and assess the market,” MGM Mirage President Jim Murren told analysts during an earnings conference call last week.

Mullen said his company halted plans for a \$1.5 billion Atlantic City casino hotel so it could pounce on potentially new gaming opportunities in other states or overseas.

“We felt that was the better move. It does not reflect poorly on Atlantic City. We did not intend to make that our message. We're very bullish on Atlantic City long term,” he said.
