Not many new chips were released this month at Trump properties ... but slot cards and room keys have been issued.

NEW ROOM KEY AT TAJ MAHAL

The Donald is finally getting around to converting his hotel room doors from the old style metal keys to today's technology using electronic plastic cards at Taj Mahal. Nice colorful keys are now in use for certain floors only. I would imagine that all floors will eventually be converted to the new electronic cards. Sorry, I don't have any quantities of these keys yet ... but I probably will by next month's mailing.



NEW POSTAL RATES ...

Note that first class letters up to 1 oz have gone to .39 cents rather than .37 cents; effective January 9th.

Also note that the current surcharge for "thick envelopes under an ounce" (which often applies to the bubble envelopes used to ship a single chip) goes to .13 cents, making the postage for these increased to .52 cents..., up from .49 cents.

The charge for each additional ounce goes from 23 cents to 24 cents, so none of your old 23's will be enough. Better stock up on some penny stamps.

Priority Mail now starts at \$4.05 rather than \$3.85.
